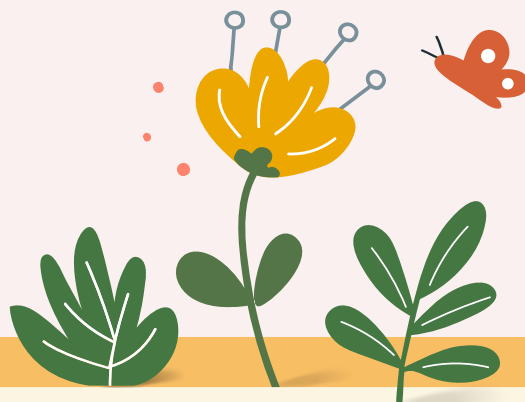


IT'S TIME FOR PRE-K NEWS!



HIGHLIGHTS FROM LAST MONTH...

Last Month our classrooms came alive while learning all about Insects. The children learnt about the different kind of insects that can be found in our immediate environment as well as the characteristics of insects. They engaged in family projects where they used their imagination and creativity to use anything they wanted to make an insect of their choice. A big pat on the back for working so hard and creating such creative insects.

We also looked closely at the Lifecycle of a butterfly. The children learnt about all 4 stages of the Lifecycle. They engaged in sensory bins where they worked on fine motor skills and matching skills to identify each stage. In class art they worked on creating the Lifecycle of a butterfly using different pasta shapes to represent each stage.

We honored Earth day by looking at Earth & Recycling. The children learnt all about the 3 R's - Reduce, Reuse and Recycle. They engaged in activities where they had to sort different recycle-able items. We discussed how we can make better choices for our earth and make small changes around us everyday. Finally, the children worked hard at creating different creations for the recycling exhibition.

As we ended the month we dived in a new theme Seasons. We started off by learning all about Spring. The children learnt about what our environment looks like at Spring time. The changes in the plants (flowers are blooming) and they learnt about how some animals that were hibernating during Winter come out in Spring time.

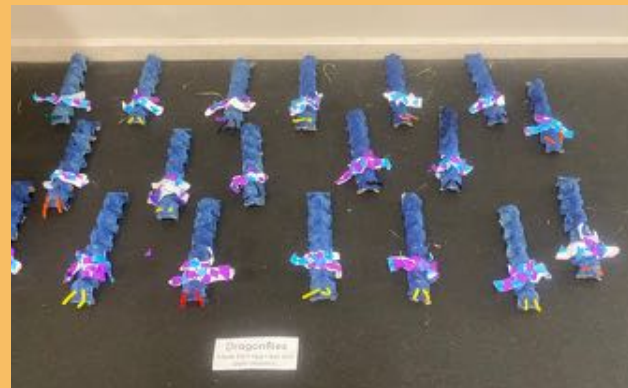
